QUICK HITTERS

- The LIU Brooklyn men's basketball team concludes its three-game homestand on Saturday as it hosts Hofstra at the Wellness, Recreation and Athletic Center.
- The Blackbirds are a perfect 2-0 thus far on the home swing, picking up wins against Columbia and most recently against Lafayette on Dec. 1.
- Three players earned double-doubles in the game, becoming the first trio of Blackbirds to earn double-figures in a pair of offensive statistical categories in the Stat Crew era (1996-97).
- Julian Boyd scored a game-high 20 points and grabbed 10 rebounds, Jamal Olasewere had 15 points and 11 boards and Jason Brickman registered 12 points and dished out 10 assists.
- LIU enters the contest with a 29-game winning streak at the Wellness, Recreation and Athletic Center. The only home loss that the Blackbirds have had over the past 30 games came in the season opener at Barclays Center against Morehead State.
- As of December 2, the Blackbirds ranked in the nation's top 30 in assist/turnover ratio (1.4 - 18th) and fewest turnovers per game (11.3- 30th).
- Junior Jason Brickman ranked fifth amongst NCAA Division I players in assists at 7.3 per game last season.
- He is averaging 8.0 per contest this season and is fifth in the category as of Dec. 6. Brickman also ranks 10th in the country in three-point field goal percentage at 53.3 percent.

After spending seven years on the LIU Brooklyn men's basketball staff, Jack Perri was named head coach in April 2012. Perri becomes the 13th head coach of an LIU program that will enter its 79th season in 2012-13.

Perri, 36, has spent seven seasons on the LIU staff, including the last five as associate head coach. He was promoted to that position in August 2007 and has played a vital role in recruiting, scouting and developing players on LIU's back-to-back Northeast Conference champion rosters.

Since joining the Blackbirds, Perri has helped the team steadily move up the ladder in the NEC, culminating in a pair of tournament and regular-season championships in both 2010-11 and 2011-12. With Perri on the staff, LIU went 25-9 this season en route to a second appearance in the NCAA Tournament Second Round.

The Blackbirds ranked second in the country in scoring (81.4 ppg) and compiled the nation's second-longest active home winning streak at 27 games. Junior Julian Boyd became the fourth player in LIU history to be named NEC Player of the Year and was joined on the all-conference teams by junior Jamal Olasewere and sophomore Jason Brickman.

In his time at LIU, Perri has seen eight players earn All-NEC honors, including Boyd, who was named conference player of the year in 2011-12 after earning rookie of the year accolades in 2008-09. For his efforts, Perri was tabbed as the top assistant in the NEC by Jeff Goodman's FoxSports.com blog prior to the 2010-11 season.

Before joining Ferry's staff at LIU, Perri served as the head men's basketball coach at Division III Rhode Island College in 2004-05. In his lone season at Rhode Island College, Perri took the Anchormen to the final of the Eastern College Athletic Conference Tournament after posting a 20-9 record. Under Perri's direction, Rhode Island College captured the program's first Little East Conference co-regular season championship and he was named the league's coach of the year in his first season at the helm.

Following his graduation from Bentley College, the Manalapan, N.J., native moved to the sidelines as the top assistant coach at his alma mater. As the top assistant from 1998 to 2004, he was responsible for all aspects of recruiting and helped build a squad that went on to earn the No. 1 national ranking in 2004-05 and a No. 2 ranking in 2006-07. During his time on the staff with the Falcons, he helped the team return to the NCAA Tournament for the first time in eight seasons in 2002.

A 1998 graduate of Bentley, Perri was a two-year captain and helped the Falcons post four winning seasons while playing in 99 career games. He was recruited to Bentley by Ferry, whom he subsequently replaced as assistant coach upon his graduation.

Perri and his wife, Julie, currently reside in Manalapan, N.J., with their sons, Sean Patrick and Jackson Richard.

LAST MEETING

- Last season, the Blackbirds and Pride met in the season opener on Nov. 11, 2012.
- Hofstra led a close game at halftime, 32-30, before taking control after intermission.
- Mike Moore and Nathaniel Lester combined to score 56 points, including 39 in the second half to lead the Pride to an 89-71 win in Hempstead. Hofstra shot 71.4 percent (15-21) in the second stanza.
- Jamal Olasewere had 13 points to lead the Blackbirds, while Jason Brickman was the only other player in double figures with 11 points. C.J. Garner added eight points and six assists.

THE SERIES

- LIU Brooklyn and Hofstra have played 28 times previously, with the Pride holding a 16-12 edge in the series.
- After a 13-year hiatus, the series picked up again last season for the first time since the 1988-89 campaign.
- The series dates all the way back to 1958-59. Hofstra won the first six games between the two schools before the Blackbirds returned the favor by winning six straight of their own between 1964-70.
- LIU is 6-5 at home in the series, with the upcoming contest being the first played at the WRAC.

SCOUTING HOFSTRA

- The Pride have lost four straight entering Saturday, including a 52-44 setback against Wagner on Dec. 4.
- Since defeating Marshall in double overtime on Nov. 18, Hofstra has failed to break the 60-point barrier and have been held to under 50 points in each of the last two games.
- Taran Buie, a transfer from Penn State, scored 16 points to lead the Pride while Stephen Nwaukoni tallied six points and grabbed 11 rebounds off the bench.

AMONGST THE NATION'S BEST

- The Blackbirds ranked 51st in scoring offense in the latest NCAA statistics, as well as in the top 30 in assist-to-turnover ratio (18th) and fewest turnovers committed (30th).
- Individually, junior Jason Brickman stood in fifth place in assists per game and 10th in three-point field goal percentage.
- Senior Jamal Olasewere stands in 30th place in points per game, while teammate Julian Boyd also cracked the top 50 and is in 47th place in scoring.

BLACKBIRDS ON TELEVISION

- LIU Brooklyn was broadcast to a national audience in three of its first four games this year.
- The Blackbirds' opener against Morehead State and contests against Maryland and Kentucky were all aired on ESPN3.
- LIU will host Robert Morris on Feb. 2 on ESPNU. LIU's road tilt vs. Wagner on Feb. 24 will also be televised on the "U".
- The Battle of Brooklyn, taking place this year on Jan. 24 at St. Francis (N.Y.), will be broadcast regionally on MSG and Fox College Sports.

LIU ON THE WEB

- For the first time ever, home LIU Brooklyn men's basketball games will be seen live via the internet.
- In conjunction with Pack Network, the Northeast Conference launched NEC Front Row, an online digital network with multi-platform access.
- All home contests and select road conference games not broadcast regionally or nationally will be seen on necfrontrow.com.

THE NORTHEAST CONFERENCE

- The Northeast Conference celebrates its 32nd anniversary this season. The 12-member conference dates back to 1981, when it originated as the men's basketball-only ECAC-Metro Conference.
- LIU Brooklyn is one of the six charter institutions that helped form the alliance in 1981, and all six schools remain affiliated with the NEC today.
- With the addition of five more colleges and universities over the years, including Bryant as a full member this season, the NEC has spread its footprint into such major media markets as New York City, Baltimore and Pittsburgh.

TRIPLE DOUBLE-DOUBLE

•Against Lafayette on Saturday, three Blackbirds registered double-double performances.

•Senior Julian Boyd led all scorers with 20 points and pulled down 10 rebounds, classmate Jamal Olasewere had 15 points and 11 boards and junior Jason Brickman added 12 points and 10 assists.

•The three double-doubles in one game marked the first time an LIU trio had pulled it off in one game since the inception of Stat Crew in 1997.

FLAWLESS PERFORMANCE

•Jason Brickman put together one of the top performances of any Northeast Conference distributor in the last decade against Lafayette.

•Brickman dished out 10 assists without committing a single turnover in 36 minutes of action.

•The last to register double-digit assists without a turnover it was SPPA guard Erick Willis on Dec. 14, 2002.

BOY-OH-BOYD

•Senior Julian Boyd has been quite efficient from the floor in his last four outings.

•After scoring 20 points on 9-for-14 shooting against Lafayette, Boyd is averaging 20.8 points on 55.7 percent shooting.

•With his 20 points against the Leopards, Boyd surpassed Kyle Johnson (2007-11) for 11th place on the all-time scoring list and is one point from all-time great Sherman White (1948-51) for 10th.

•White was considered one of the premier college

basketball players in the nation during his time, and was named Second Team All-American and won New York's prestigious Haggerty Award as the New York Metropolitan Area's top player.

FROM WAY DOWNTOWN

•Junior Jason Brickman has been nothing short of spectacular from three-point range this season.

•Brickman knocked down two of his four attempts from long range against Lafayette, and is now shooting 53.3 percent (16-30) from three-point range.

•Currently, Brickman ranks second in the Northeast Conference in three-point field goal percentage behind Stephon Whyatt of Saint Francis (Pa.), and 10th in the nation

HOME IS WHERE THE WINS ARE

•LIU Brooklyn has been stunningly successful at the Wellness, Recreation and Athletic Center over the past three years.

•The Blackbirds are currently on a 29-game winning streak at the WRAC dating back to Dec. 8, 2010 (L, 88-82 vs. Iona).

•LIU is 53-8 (.869 winning %) at the WRAC and 32-4 (.889) in NEC games since the beginning of the 2008-09 season.

DISHING AND SWISHING

•Jason Brickman has started off his junior campaign with a flourish, averaging 13.5 ppg and 8.0 apg through five contests.

•Brickman ranks high on the NEC career assists chart, and needs just 2 more to break into the top-25 and 57 more to reach the top 10.

•Brickman's assist average ranks fifth in the country in the early going of the season.

DYNAMIC DUO

•Senior forwards Jamal Olasewere and Julian Boyd are each off to terrific starts in their final season at LIU.

•Boyd is averaging 19.2 points per game while Olasewere leads the team at 20.0 ppg.

•As of Monday, the duo was the third-highest scoring tandem in the nation at 39.2 ppg behind Iona's MoMo Jones & Sean Armand (41.4 ppg), and Cal's Allen Crabbe & Justin Cobbs (41.1 ppg).

CHARITY APPEARANCES

•Jamal Olasewere has been getting to the free-throw line at a very high rate in 2012-13.

•Olasewere has been to the free-throw line 59 times, an average of 10.8 per game to lead the nation (Erick Green of Vermont is only other player to average in double figures at 10.4).

•Olasewere also is averaging a team-high 20.0 points per game, to go along with 7.0 rebounds, 2.3 steals and 1.2 blocks per outing.

FREE FOR ME

•LIU Brooklyn led the nation in 2011-12 in free-throws made per game at 20.9 per contest.

•This year, the Blackbirds are averaging 27.3 appearances at the charity stripe over four games and have made 19.0 per game.

•LIU has eclipsed the 30 free-throws attempted threshold three times, including 36 against Columbia on Wednesday.

2012-13 LIU Brooklyn Men's Basketball • Two-Time Defending NEC Champions

PRESEASON ACCOLADES

- A number of LIU Brooklyn men’s basketball players were recognized by analysts prior to the start of the 2012-13 campaign.
- Senior Julian Boyd was once again named to the Lou Henson Preseason All-America Team and was recognized by CBSSports.com as one of the top 30 “under the radar” players in the country.
- Boyd was also named the NEC Preseason Player of the Year for the second straight season by CBS Sports.
- Joining Boyd on the “under the radar” list was classmate Jamal Olasewere. The duo also garnered Preseason All-NEC accolades.

LIU STRIKES GOLD IN SILVER SPRING

- In the fall of 2009, the LIU Brooklyn men’s basketball program welcomed the addition of a pair of players from Silver Spring, Md.
- Jamal Olasewere was an incoming freshman, while C.J. Garner played his first year at South Alabama before transferring to LIU.
- After Garner sat out a year due to NCAA transfer requirements, and Olasewere was named to the NEC All-Rookie Team in 2009-10, the duo has helped the Blackbirds to back-to-back NEC titles and 52 victories over two years.
- Winning is nothing new to the pair, as they led Springbrook High School to a 2008 Maryland 4A State Title. In 2009, with Garner away at college, Olasewere helped the Blue Devils to a second straight state championship.

FROM FERRY TO PERRI

- Jack Perri was named the 13th coach in the history of the LIU Brooklyn men’s basketball program in April 2012.
- Perri has an extensive coaching background at all levels of college basketball, including a year as head coach at Division III Rhode Island College.
- The Manalapan, N.J. native was named Little East Coach of the Year in his lone season at the helm of the Panthers, leading them to a 20-9 record and a conference title.
- Perri played four seasons at Bentley College and was a two-time captain, helping his team to a winning record in each of his four years.

TEXAS CONNECTION

- LIU Brooklyn has built a pipeline to the Lonestar State of Texas over the last decade.
- Currently, six players on the LIU roster hail from the state, including projected starters Julian Boyd, Jason Brickman and Brandon Thompson.
- Since 2002-03, the Blackbirds have had 13 different players don the Black & Silver, including a pair of 1,000-point scorers in Boyd and James Williams (2003-07).

HOME AWAY FROM HOME

- LIU Brooklyn reached an agreement with Barclays Center this past March on a unique multi-faceted partnership, which includes athletics, education, community, and brand-building platforms.
- The Blackbirds’ men’s basketball team will play a minimum of four games at Barclays Center each season during the length of the agreement, the first of which was against Morehead State on Nov. 9. Other games scheduled are Seton Hall (Dec. 22), Mount St. Mary’s (Jan. 12), and St. Francis (N.Y.) (Feb. 10).
- As part of the educational component of the alliance, Barclays Center will annually host five one-hour bi-weekly classes for students in the LIU Sports Management Degree program.
- In addition, at least five LIU students will annually receive internships with Barclays Center or Nets Basketball.
- LIU Brooklyn will hold graduation at Barclays Center for the entire campus throughout the duration of the agreement.

BLACKBIRDS BASKETBALL HISTORY

- LIU has over 1,100 wins with 10 NIT and five NCAA Tournament appearances.
- The Blackbirds won NIT tournament championships in 1939 and 1941.
- Clair Bee spent 18 years at LIU and owns the NCAA’s highest career winning percentage (.826).
- The Blackbirds went undefeated in 1935-36 (25-0) and 1938-39 (24-0). They won 43 straight in 1935-37, the sixth-longest streak in NCAA history.
- LIU boasts nine All-Americans in its history, including Ossie Schectman who scored the first basket in NBA history while playing for the Knicks.
- Charles Jones won back-to-back national scoring titles in 1996-97 (30.1 ppg) and 1997-98 (29.0 ppg). Carey Scurry was the NCAA’s leading rebounder in 1984-85 with 14.1 boards per game.

WHY THE BLACKBIRDS?

According to Dr. Elliott S.M. Gatner, an early historian of LIU, the first student-athletes representing the university in intercollegiate competition in the late 1920’s and early 1930’s were known as the Blue Devils. The teams earned the moniker because of the blue color of their uniforms. In LIU’s earliest days, the basketball players were called “Beemen,” after their legendary coach, Clair F. Bee, a member of the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame.

Sometime between February and October of 1935, the uniform color was changed to black and the Blue Devils became the Blackbirds. The story goes that a reporter for the borough’s famed Brooklyn Eagle observed the players in their black uniforms running down the court dribbling the basketball, reminded him of blackbirds back home, bobbing up and down as they fed in the cornfields. In filing his story of the game, the writer who came to New York from the Midwest used “Blackbirds” and it has stuck ever since.

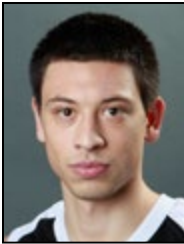
